AN APPEAL FOR ISSUES IN FARM AVENUE A MESSAGE FROM YOUR SUDBURY LABOUR COUNCILLORS

We are writing to you as your local Labour Councillors in Sudbury. We recently knocked on doors on your street to discuss any local issues you had in your area, just thought we would get in touch to update you on some actions we have taken.

Following some very helpful conversations with residents in Farm Avenue, we have taken up a number of concerns on behalf of you and your neighbours. In particular:

- **We're working to improve the footpath and green space in Farm Avenue.** After raising this with the Council, we have cleared the footpath of weeds and have just supported a Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) bid to plant bulbs and flowers in the grass in the central T junction in Farm Avenue, to give the area some colour
- **We will continue to report potholes and pavement issues.** We reported several issues when doorknocking and have returned to the area since to make further reports. If you notice any other issues, please do not hesitate to contact us
- **We have heard concerns about litter and fly tips in the area, and have been flagging these issues with Brent Council's enforcement team.** We have noticed particular issues towards the north-west of Farm Avenue where it intersects with Chaplin Road, and towards the south near One Tree Hill Recreation Ground. These have been reported. The Council will now be emptying the bins near One Tree Hill daily, rather than every second day as before.
- **We have received reports of crime and anti-social behaviour, especially near One Tree Hill Recreation ground.** This has been reported to both the police and the Council's anti-social behaviour team; and also raised at Sudbury Safer Neighbourhood Team meetings. We will continue to monitor this issue and flag issues with the police - please do keep ourselves and the local police updated on any issues you have.

We will continue to press the Council on these issues, and we want to hear more from you about any issues you have.
